INDIANAPOLIS -- A total of 105 participants will compete in the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championships.



The championships will be held May 16-19, at The Resort at Glade Springs in Daniels, West Virginia. The championships are being hosted by Concord University and The West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

The winner of each region from the super regionals received an automatic berth to the finals. In addition to the ten automatic berths, three additional berths were allotted to the Atlantic/Southeast super regional, three to the South/South Central super regional and four to the West/Northwest super regional. The top individual from each super regional site not on an advancing team also was selected to compete.
