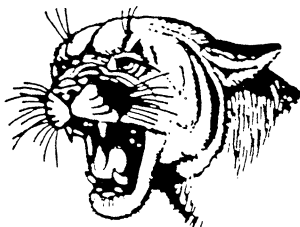

Tournament Lodging:

The Resort at Glade Springs is the official headquarters for the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championship. The resort has set aside rooms at \$150 per night, plus tax, (including all three meals) for participants starting Saturday, May 13, 2006. Each institution is responsible for faxing a rooming list and reservation request upon determination they are a participant. The form, found in this information packet, must be faxed to the attention of Tanja Daniels at 304/763-0420. Once your reservation is faxed in, a confirmation fax and/or e-mail will be sent within 24 hours.

Parents and spectators wishing to stay at the Resort at Glade Springs can call 1/800-634-5233 for reservations. A block of rooms at a rate of \$165 per night has been set aside based on availability. To take advantage of this reserved block, parents and fans must identify themselves as requesting a room at the NCAA Family Block.

Registration:

Registration for the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championship will take place in the Governor's Room of the Inn at Glade Springs on Saturday May 13 from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. and on Sunday, May 14 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

During registration, each coach shall submit a lineup according to playing position. A lineup form will be supplied and the five participants from each competing institution must be determined. No substitutions will be allowed after the conclusion of registration without the approval of the NCAA Division II Men's Golf Committee. If a substitution is made prior to the end of registration, the substitute will assume the position of the replaced player.

NCAA Championship Banquet:

The NCAA will host a championship banquet on Monday, May 15 in the Glade Room. This banquet is open to participants, tournament officials, and host staff.

Championship Meeting:

The games committee for the NCAA will conduct a championship meeting to review tournament procedures and local rules on Monday, May 15 immediately following the championship banquet. It is mandatory that each coach or institutional representative attend this meeting. A fine (\$100) will be assessed for violation of this policy.

Training Information:

Concord University will provide athletic training staff for the competition. All athletic training facilities will be available to the athletes a minimum of one hour before the first tee time until one hour following the final group completes play. This includes practice rounds, as well as rounds of competition.

Drug Testing:

Student-athletes who compete in the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championship may be subject to drug tests in accordance with NCAA Bylaws 18.4.1.5 and 31.2.3 and may be determined to be ineligible as a result thereof. Only student-athletes who have consented in writing to such testing are initially eligible for the championship; and thereafter, student-athletes who are tested shall remain eligible only if test results are negative.

Upon qualification for the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championship, each institution is to submit the following information:

Accurate roster (including names, class, and hometown)

Complete results for the 2005-06.

Individual statistics for the 2005-06 season.

Media Credentials:

All media interested in covering the championship should submit a request to Will Prewitt at the above address. Written requests may be e-mailed, faxed, or mailed. Credentials will be issued at the Resort at Glade Springs.

Daily Results:

Live scoring will be available at www.golfstat.com. Links to live scoring may also be found at www.ncaasports.com, the official NCAA Championships website. A link to a local tournament website may be found at www.concordmountainlions.com or www.wviac.org. Full results will be available at the course and at the host hotel as soon as possible following the conclusion of each round.

Meals:

The lodging package for the championship includes three meals from Sunday through Friday. The schedule for these meals can be found on the master tournament event schedule.

Mementos:

Coaches and participants will each receive mementos of their trip to the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championship. Coaches and participants will receive a framed commemorative plaque, as well as a money clip and pewter bagtag.

Equipment:

The type of equipment to be used shall be determined by the individual school and must be acceptable under USGA rules. Golf bags must have the name or logo of the school on them. Players and coaches will be required to use non-metal spiked shoes during the championship. This includes all practice rounds.

Carts:

Carts, pull carts, and caddies may not be used by participants during any part of the championship. Golf carts will only be provided for members of the games committee and selected tournament officials. The use of carts by any other personnel (coaches, players, spectators) must be approved by the NCAA Division II Men's Golf Committee. The only exception to this policy would be if the participant is permanently disabled. A written request must be submitted to the NCAA committee with accompanying medical statements requesting the use of a cart.

Scoring Volunteers:

Golfstat will provide live scoring for each day of competition. Volunteers will be positioned at each green and players are asked to provide their score to these volunteers. Volunteers will be clearly identifiable and should not impede the play or pace of the participants.

Spectators:

Spectators shall remain on cart paths or in the rough and approximately 15 yards away from the participants. There may be no communication between players and spectators that could be deemed advice of any nature for the duration of the 18 holes. The designated coach is the only person permitted to dispense food or drinks to the participants. All insitutional personnel, with the exception of the designated coach, are considered spectators. *Please remember that all cell phones and other similar electronic devices must have ringers turned off!*

Airport Information:

Yeager Field in Charleston, West Virginia is the closest major airport. Yeager Field is approximately 65 miles (1:10) from the Resort at Glade Springs. The Raleigh County Airport is a smaller airport with a limited number of flights into Beckley, West Virginia. It is located approximately ten minutes from the resort. Other major airport options are Roanoke, Virginia (2:30) and Greensboro, North Carolina (3:15).

Southern West Virginia Information:

Weather:

Spring weather in Southern West Virginia is typically pleasant with average mid-May highs in the low 70's and lows around 50. However, it can get cool on occasion and a light jacket and/or rain gear is advisable.

Driving Directions:

From I-64 West:

Take exit 129 (Shady Springs, Grandview Road Exit)

Turn left onto 9 South Shady Spring

Go 4.2 miles to intersection and turn left onto Route 19 South

Go .3 miles and The Resort at Glade Springs will be on the left

From I-77 North:

Take exit 28 (Ghent Exit), at the end of the exit ramp turn right, which will bring you to Route 19

Turn left onto Route 19 North

Go 10 miles and The Resort at Glade Springs will be on the right

From I-77 South to I-64 East:

Take exit 125A (Beaver Exit) into Route 307 West

Go 2 miles to intersection and turn left onto Route 19 South

Go 2.8 miles and The Resort at Glade Springs will be on the left

From Yeager Airport in Charleston, WV:

Follow directions for I-77 South to I-64

From Beckley Airport:

Coming out of the airport is Route 307 West

Go 3 miles to intersection and turn left onto Route 19 South

Go 2.8 miles and The Resort at Glade Springs will be on the left

Please note that the West Virginia Turnpike (I-77) south from Charleston is a toll road. You will pass through two toll booths (\$1.25 each) between the airport and the resort. The resort is approximately just over an hour from Charleston. It is a bit more than three hours from Charlotte, North Carolina for those travelers driving from the south.

The Cobb Course:

Consistently ranked one of the best golf courses in West Virginia, The Cobb Course is considered one of the best of over 300 George Cobb designed courses. The Resort at Glade Springs has completed a comprehensive upgrade to The Cobb Course lengthening it to over 7,000 yards while maintaining the classic integrity of its original design. Along with the numerous aesthetic changes, championship tees have been added to all eighteen holes. In addition to the newly expanded teeing areas, several fairway bunkers have been strategically placed throughout the course. To prepare for your round our newly renovated and expanded practice facility will help sharpen your skills.

This course has over 200 feet of elevation change, 54 sand bunkers, eight lakes, ever-changing sun angles, and fairways that subtly - or suddenly - slope the "wrong" way. You'll quickly learn that every green has its own quirks and pin placements can make or break your score.
